The centre is running a three months course on 'Karbi language'

Sonapur College Museum: The College has its mission to preserve the cultural heritage of the locality and a Committee has been formed for the functioning of the museum. The College has collected various artefacts from the neighbouring areas related to tradition and culture.

Dekachang: Dekachang or Chamati is a traditional concept belonging to the Tiwa Community. Dekachang provides a platform for the tribal youths to get training for their livelihood. Dekachang is almost on the verge of extinction and thus the College took it as its Mission to preserve this cultural artefact. The Dekachang is used as Boys common room.
