DDU Kaushal Kendra

With a view to expand the scope of vocational education on a larger scale and to a newer level by offering courses beyond B.Voc degree, the UGC has introduced the DeenDayalUpadhyay Centre for Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood (DDU KAUSHAL) in universities and colleges recently. The University Grants Commission has granted the status of the DDU KAUSHAL Kendra to Sonapur College, the only college under Gauhati University amongst the 48 HE institutions across the country. Under the scheme the UGC has approved the B.Voc Degree Programmes on 'Theatre & Stagecraft', 'Retail Management & IT' and 'Travel & Tourism Management' with facilities for multiple exits in one year with Diploma, two years with Advanced Diploma and three years with B.Voc. Degree.

UGC Funded B. Voc. Degree Programmes

The college has introduced new courses namely B. Voc. Degree programmes in 'Theatre & Stagecraft' and 'Retail Management & IT' under financial assistance from UGC. A theatre hall and a computer laboratory with state of the art facility have been set-up for the purpose.
