

Findings and Analysis


The survey results show that a vast majority of the students are satisfied with the academic environment of the college. As far as the criterion of course coverage is concerned the most of students have expressed their satisfaction on it. Regarding faculty competence a number of questions are included in the questionnaire. The students have appreciated the faculty competence especially in connection with the ability of the teachers to communicate with the students in imparting the contents of the syllabus along with creating a proper teaching learning atmosphere in the college. The students also have placed on record the approachability and supporting nature of the staff members in learning the soft skill as well as the life skills. In connection with the use of multimedia while teaching, the students through their rating expressed their necessity of the use of more such tools in classrooms. Regarding the internal evaluation process, the survey exhibits good rating from students with a maximum number of entries in 'always fair' option. They also feel that the teachers help them in finding out their weakness and also overcoming them by assigning multiple related tasks. The college adopts various initiatives to engage students in field visits. The students have recorded high value in this regard. The feedback analysis shows the agreement of the students in the effort of the institution to engage students in the continuous quality improvement and self review. Regarding the obswrvation on mentoring and the cognitive, social and emotional health the students have recorded that very often they are provided the support from the faculty members. The SSS analysis makes it clear that the students strongly agree with the good quality of overall quality of the teaching learning process of the college.


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.






10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.






18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.
