2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The global pandemic of COVID 19 has created an unprecedented situation in all sectors. The impact on the education sector has created a gap among all its stakeholders. As Educational needs cannot be avoided and the issues have to be addressed from a practical point of view. According to guidelines laid down by competent authorities, online classes for students are being held by the departments apart from organising student centric and faculty-oriented webinars. Further the college has made necessary arrangements in accordance with the instructions laid down by the government regarding precautionary measures. The college follows regular sanitisation process, wearing of masks, and social distancing to ensure a safe and hygienic environment. The institution adopts the following measures to ensure coverage of syllabus of course and programmes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Every department convenes departmental meeting to divide the syllabus among the faculty members much ahead of the beginning of the academic session. •Teaching plan is prepared in accordance with the number of classes allotted to the students. •Regular orientation classes at the beginning of every session to aware the students about the structure of the syllabus and thereby ensuring their presence in the classes. •The regular maintenance of the Departmental Academic progress report helps the teachers to have an accountability about the progress of the course. •There is a continuous practice of holding an academic meeting convened by the Principal with all the teaching staff to monitor the progress of the course at least one month before the commencement of examination. •Departmental meetings are convened to monitor the progress of the syllabus. •The students are made aware of the Course outcome and programme outcomes that are available in the website of the college. •Introduction of Google classroom turns out to be of immense help to disseminate to study material to gear up students for self-study. •Regular holding of classroom presentation promotes learning by doing and thereby to cover the syllabus within limited time span. The same is also conducted in the online mode too. •Peer teaching is encouraged all faculties to train the advanced learners so that they can facilitate the slow learners' learning. •The institution regularly conducts feedback from students on teachers as well as on course. Under this mechanism evaluation is done by the Principal in association with IQAC leading to the convening of a meeting by the principal for preparing an Action Taking Report. The Head of the Departments are intimated with the suggestions for improvement. Then the Head of the Departments conduct meetings with the faculty members of respective department for taking measures to complete the syllabus if any portion of the syllabus is left undone. <p>In respect of the PG classes monthly review meetings are held with the students to know about the progress of the course. The departments of Geography, Assamese and English conducted their classes online during Pandemic using different Online Platforms namely Zoom, Google Classroom, Teachmint, etc. by ensuring optimum attendance and ensured completion of syllabi so that the students' academic performance is not hampered.</p>
